

## Words from Wayne

I'm very impressed by the way the Fayetteville churches cross denominational lines to support ministries that benefit the community. I'm also proud of the fact that our church has been the instigator and supporter of several very important community service missions. Operation Inasmuch began at Snyder but now dozens of churches in our community participate. Sue Byrd told me the other day that she had to go back to the neighborhood where we're working April 4 to find more homes that needed help because churches continue to come forward asking for projects. Jean and I went down to Hay Street Methodist for the OIAM fundraiser lunch last week. Serving the meal right along side Snyder folks were folks from many other churches.

Another Snyder instigated ministry is the Fayetteville Family Life Center. Russ Davenport, Dianne Palmer, Joel Jenkins and I serve on that board along with 24 other folks from churches across the community. Thirty-five years ago Jim Cammack was instrumental in getting the School of Pastoral Care at Baptist Hospital to open that center and we've supported it financially all these years. That ministry provides faith based counseling to any one who needs it regardless of ability to pay. Last year the center provided over 9,000 hours of counseling services and that will probably jump to 14,000 this year with the opening of the Westmont Center. In tough times like these, folks are desperate for help as they try to cope with the world. Thirty churches financially support this ministry. To cover operating costs and provide care for those with limited means, we have to have fundraisers. Join us Sunday, March 8, at 3:00pm in the Sanctuary for An Afternoon of Inspirational Music featuring some of Cumberland County's most talented folks. Admission is free, but there will be an offering to benefit the center.

Jesus said, "Unto the least of these..." Thank you for taking him seriously and for joining your fellow Christians in doing ministry. That's one more reason why I'm proud to be a minister at Snyder Memorial Baptist Church. -Wayne

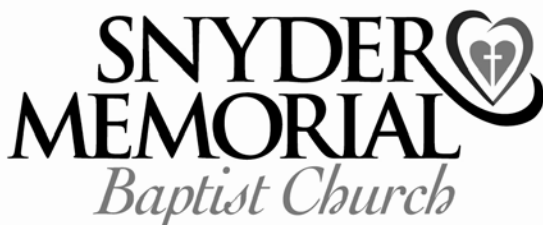

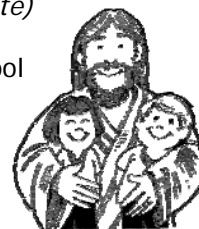

CAR CHECKUP- Provided for singles, elderly and deployed military spouses. Offer free, minor checkup on fluid levels, tire pressure, etc.

JUVENILE DETENTION CENTER - provide a craft project for the youth and a short devotional time. ADULTS ONLY due to confidentiality. (6-7 people needed).

LANDSCAPE TEAM-This team will landscaping different homes for hospice.

LAUNDRO-MAT PROJECT-Volunteers will take food, supplies, and quarters to a local laundro-mat and sharing the food with people washing their clothes and feed the machines for them.

MAKEOVER PARTY FOR RESIDENTS OF A HOMELESS SHELTER - Team will go and do makeover party for the girls living in the Alberta Green home.

MINISTRY TEAMS - These teams will visit in the homes where we are doing repair work. They will share the Gospel of Jesus Christ and why we are working on their home. This signup is limited to 4 people.

PROVIDE LUNCH AT THE SALVATION ARMY - this group will cook the meal on Saturday morning and then take it to the Salvation Army and serve it from 11am till 1pm.

SPORTS CAMPS FOR MARGARET WILLIS SCHOOL CHILDREN-A morning sports camp will be conducted for the children of Margaret Willis school. Teens are encouraged to help with the project as well as adults.
