Summer Camp- Is a week long summer events that foster **growth, community, service and worship** in the lives of our students.

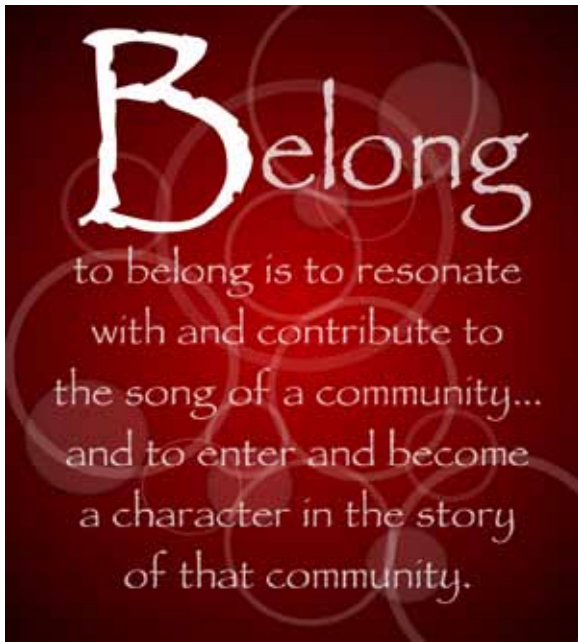
