Operation InAsMuch- OIAM is a one day service blitz which gives us an opportunity to **serve our community** in a hands-on way.

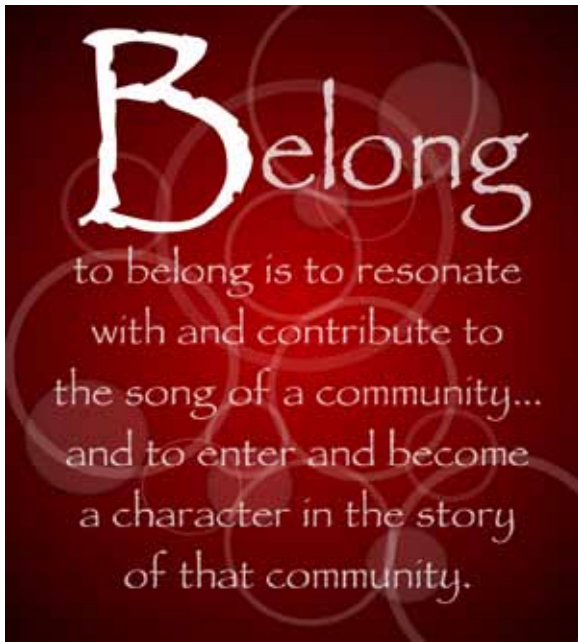
