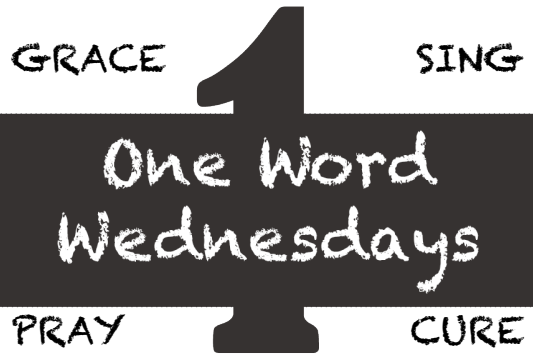

Pastor's Perspective

One of my neighbors has a sign in their front yard that says, "My teacher misses me. My parents miss my teacher more." I have talked to several parents in recent weeks who have a much greater appreciation for teachers in general and their children's teachers specifically. Let's just say home-schooling isn't every parent's cup of tea. I talked to one teacher this past weekend who misses her students. Teachers have had to adapt to using technology, but it's not the same without the personal interaction in the classroom.

This is just one example - one no one saw coming - of how we often don't appreciate what we have until we don't have it anymore. I can vividly remember going through Ranger School for nine weeks back in 1977 eating one c-ration a day thinking about all kinds of foods I wanted to eat when I got out. My eyes were bigger than my stomach at the first buffet lunch we had the day we graduated. Both of our sons are missing their barbers right now. Their hair has never been so long in their entire lives. Our family is getting more than a few laughs from some of the pictures they are sharing with us.

But sometimes the things we lose are of significantly more consequence. Our health. If we live long enough, we'll get to the place that we can't do the things we used to do. Our loved ones. Too often we subconsciously assume they'll always be with us... until they aren't. Our liberties, including the right to assemble for worship. That's one of many things this pandemic has taken away from us - at least for a season. This loss of liberty is something we Americans can easily take for granted and is a major source of the increasing frustration we are seeing across our nation. People are restless... for freedom.

In the midst of today's very real challenges, I find great comfort in the fact that some things can never be taken away. My relationship with my Lord and Savior, Jesus Christ, for one. And all of the blessings in this life and in the life to come that are mine - and yours - because of that relationship. Thanks be to God for His indescribable gift!
